College Uniform and Appearance Policy

Rationale

Catholic schools have a long tradition of student uniforms as an important dimension of school life. School uniforms provide a strong sense of identity and contribute to inclusivity and equity in schools. It is a significant expectation at Mater Dei Catholic College that all students will wear the correct uniform, and are supported in this by their parents/carers.

The uniform reflects the College community's standards and expectations as well as assisting the school community to:

- Promote a sense of inclusiveness, non-discrimination and equity – students are known for who they are and what they do, not what they wear
- Foster the ethos of Catholic schools where all people are treated equally regardless of financial circumstances
- Recognise its student members
- Define the identity of the school within its broader community
- Promote College spirit
- Foster the College as an ordered and safe environment, where students gain an increasing appreciation of positive personal presentation
- Eliminate the risk of peer pressure to wear clothes which might be inappropriate, transitory items of fashion and/or expensive in nature
- Provide some quality control over the durability of clothing items.

Every member of the College community plays a valued role in supporting and strengthening positive school culture on a daily basis. As they are highly visible and symbolic, uniform and appearance standards are a part of fostering the overall culture at Mater Dei. Thus students, parents/carers and staff must share responsibility for student compliance with maintaining high standards regarding both uniform and overall student appearance.

Roles and Responsibilities

Mater Dei Catholic College will:

- Inform parents/carers of the Uniform and Personal Appearance Policy when they enrol their child
- Include the Uniform and Appearance Policy statement on the College website
- Seek ongoing support from parents/carers and the school community for the Uniform and Appearance Policy and its implementation, through communications such as newsletters and parent meetings.

- Ensure that all students wear the correct uniform and fully comply with the College's policy
- Ensure that parents/carers are informed of days of the week that the College uniform and Sports uniform are to be worn
- Inform students and parents/carers that participation in school events, excursions, carnivals, outings or activity is dependent upon the student complying with this Policy
- Contact parents/carers if a student has not adhered to this policy. Parents will receive a notification confirming when a student is not in their correct uniform. This is provided to parents for their information regardless of whether a note has not been provided.
- Provide access to the Uniform Shop at designated opening times and inform parents/carers of those opening hours. Where financial issues arise Mater Dei will support families with the provision of uniform items, where possible.

Parents/carers will:

- Ensure that students dress in the approved College uniform as per the Policy.
- Support the College's Uniform and Appearance Policy
- Ensure each student's uniform is clean, pressed and in good condition
- Instruct each child to wear the full and correct uniform between home and school at all times
- Clearly and permanently mark all clothing with the child's name
- Ensure that the Sports uniform is worn only on designated sports days
- Remind children that the school hat is worn for all outdoor activities
- Ensure that jewellery is limited to two items of jewellery in line with the Mater Dei Appearance Policy
- Ensure that the child's hair is well-groomed and worn in alignment with the Mater Dei Appearance Policy.

Students will:

- Be aware of the College's Uniform and Appearance Policy
- Accept shared responsibility for complying with the required uniform and personal appearance requirements set out in the Policy
- Act as positive role models for other students in all aspects of wearing the uniform and maintaining acceptable standards with their personal appearance
- Wear the full and correct uniform between home and school at all times
- Not wear additional items for warmth that are visible under the uniform

Mater Dei Catholic College Appearance Policy

Jewellery:

Two items of jewellery may be worn:

- One chain necklace
- One ring
- One bangle or bracelet
- Students are permitted to wear one set of small gold or silver studs or sleepers limited to one in each earlobe.

For safety reasons:

- No jewellery items are to be worn in any face piercing (including tongue and nose piercings)
- Sharp or protruding items are not to be worn.

Hair

- Hair is to be tidy and neither grown, cut nor groomed in an extreme or exaggerated fashion
- Hairstyles should be neat and well groomed
- Where long enough to be tied back, then hair must be tied back
- Hair should not obscure the face
- No contrast in hair colours (naturally blended hair will be accepted).

Make-up:

- Students are not to wear make-up as part of their daily presentation.
- Coloured nail polishes and lipsticks are not permitted.

Tattoos:

- Tattoos are not to be visible.

Shoes:

- Black leather lace up shoes must be worn with the College Uniform.
